



## The Sun

Just as the Sun is the centre of the earth's Solar System, so does the Sun play a vital role in your life on earth. Your life goals are linked to your Sun - its Zodiac Sign and its position in your chart. Contrary to popular belief, the Sun isn't the only planet to be considered in a person's chart, but it is an important component. The Sun gives you an indication of how you can shine in your life. You will feel truly alive when you're living the traits indicated by your Sun. Therefore it's likely that you will spend much of your life on a journey to self discovery, aiming to incorporate these traits into your life. Understanding the energy of your Sun is a good starting point to understanding yourself and your purpose in life.

## The Sun is in the 7th House

Your Sun is in the 7th House of your birth chart meaning that relationships are a major feature of your life, both personal and business ones. You feel most warm-hearted and loving when relating to other people, in particular your primary partner. You really shine in your own life when happily married, living or working closely with someone else in partnership. ## The Moon

Astrologers from different schools of thought allocate varying meanings to the Moon in a birth chart. Ancient astrologers say that the Moon changes its nature according to its phases, and merely passes on impressions from other planets rather than directly influencing a person's life. However, modern astrologers tell us that the Moon depicts a person's roots, our home and family. They say the Moon also shows our habitual nature or subconscious patterns of behaviour which stand in the way of achieving our life goals. While the Moon can show us our strengths, it can also depict our weaknesses which need to be overcome in order to be successful in life.

#### The Moon is in the 10th House

The Moon is placed in the 10th House of your birth chart suggesting that you're ambitious and enjoy your job, spending much time in the workplace, working odd hours to make sure that you get ahead in your career. You've a need to be publicly recognised for your achievements, and this need may or may not be satisfied during your lifetime. ## The Moon is in Libra

Not for you sitting alone on a hillside watching the hues of the sunset. You want your loved one close by your side. ## The Moon is Sesquisquare Mars

## Mercury

Our academic schooling and learning through life experience are linked to the planet Mercury. This planet stands for the intellect, common sense, cold reason, commerce and business. It tells us about our communication and learning habits and our modes of thinking.

#### Mercury is in the 7th House

The planet Mercury in the 7th House of your chart signifies that relationships play an important role in your educative process. As a child this could be a significant relationship with a teacher, or one of your parents playing a major role in your education. ## **Venus**

The planet Venus tells about love and relationships. ## Mars

These are the types of questions answered by the qualities of the planet Mars in our chart.

## Mars is in the 5th House

With Mars placed in the 5th House of your birth chart you have a tendency to over-indulge in pleasures of life and can be guite stubborn if anyone tries to point out your excesses. Positively this means that you know how to enjoy the best in life, but it can also indicate a tendency to go overboard in your efforts to enjoy yourself. Rich food, expensive alcohol, or romantic liaisons can be a great source of pleasure. While this in itself is not a problem, you're not one to take heed of the saying "all things in moderation" and therefore you tend to go overboard. In some cases it's possible that your work is your pleasure and that you burn the candle at both ends believing that you can take the pressure because you enjoy your work. Of course you have the ability to direct your love of pleasure into positive pursuits, but this usually comes after the excesses have taken their physical toll. Then it's a hard road back to health and vitality. However, this can be an enjoyable challenge and you could benefit from hard muscular workouts in the gymnasium. Competitive sports and athletics may also appeal. Other influences in your chart may determine the nature of your physical exercise. There's a strong possibility that you decide against having any children of your own, and in a woman's chart the placement of the planet Mars in the 5th House of a chart can indicate difficulties with childbirth. However, it's also possible that one child is born, and perhaps even another with a large age gap in between. If you do break the mould and decide to have several children then they are likely to be very independent leaving you plenty of time and energy for pursuing your own interests, perhaps even involving periods of separation.

#### Mars is in Gemini

The planet Mars in the Sign of Gemini indicates that you like to initiate ideas and spread information, and

can often be found at the hub of communications whether it be at work or home. In fact life can be quite noisy and erratic for those around you. A restless person, you find it difficult to settle down to a single activity and often have to juggle several ongoing commitments. Fortunately you're a dexterous person, who mostly seems to be able to handle several projects at once. You know most of the tricks of the trade and can easily sidestep any problems. Although sometimes your rash behaviour can land you in a spot of trouble, in which you need all of your resources to see you through. You like to learn through your own mistakes rather than rely on other people's advice. You have a tendency to collect information from all sources trying out all of their advice for yourself. You're ardent in your pursuit of education whether it be through study, travelling, reading or everyday life. It's also likely that you're adept at writing or teaching.

## Mars is Square Uranus

The unfavourable combination of the planets Mars and Uranus suggests that you're often restless and unsettled in your life. On the one hand you seem to have plenty of energy and drive, but on the other you're not always sure what to do with these qualities. Life also has a tendency to upset the very best of your plans through sudden and often inexplicable events. This can be exciting or disturbing depending on other influences in your chart. You're enthusiastic and highly self-motivated, if somewhat impulsive, enjoying adventure and new horizons. You're full of good ideas, and once you've determined on a course of action then you've plenty of motivation to see it through to successful completion. You're independent and prefer to be given plenty of room to carry through your own ideas in your own way. Be careful that a stubborn streak in your nature doesn't prevent your overall success. It's likely that some of your friends think that you're a little odd or eccentric, but you're not overly concerned. You like to make your own way in life, even if it does mean that you stand out from the crowd. Full of paradoxes, you can be both arrogant or charming, which can make you an effective salesperson.

## **CAREER AND AMBITIONS**



## Saturn

The planet Saturn represents responsibility, boundaries and structure; structure that provides a positive framework within which we can build, or structure that limits our development and forces us to reassess our liabilities and assets. This planet is also linked with our ambitions, and how we approach the practical side of life. This planet often represents the professional side of our lives.

## Saturn is in the 2nd House

The planet Saturn placed in the 2nd House of your birth chart suggests that money is a serious business, with your personal finances requiring careful thought and planning. Your ability to earn money is influenced by other aspects in your chart. If you've good influences then you're able to slowly and steadily earn your person income through hard work and prudent investment. However, if you've difficult influences then earning money is likely to be a source of concern. Perhaps you work hard, but only seem to earn enough money to pay your bills, with little left over for luxuries. You could suffer monetary losses through loss of employment or unwise investments. Whether your finances gradually improve or continual to be a struggle, you need to plan carefully rather than make hasty decisions. Avoid impulse buying and get-rich-quick schemes. Don't let the lack of money affect your self-esteem, but learn to value other achievements and assets in your life. The good news is that the planet Saturn teaches us lessons through the school of hard knocks. Therefore you can achieve your personal financial goals later in life, even if the earlier years have proven a little challenging.

#### **Saturn is in Aquarius**

The planet Saturn in the Sign of Aquarius signifies that you're a sociable and affable person, who has the ability to work well in groups and organisations. You seem to make friends effortlessly and to benefit from your contacts with other people, particularly in your chosen profession. You're thoughtful and able to communicate with people from all walks of life. In fact you're a faithful friend and co-worker with a gift for creating mutually-beneficial contacts. Your work is often original and innovative, drawing the attention of other people. Sometimes you work in fields that are a little off the beaten track, but you also have the

ability to be quite profound in any situation which requires original ideas. The fields of science and metaphysics may feature strongly in your life. Astrologically speaking the planet Saturn is considered to be favourably placed in the Sign of Aquarius which means that you're likely to benefit through your contacts with other people, enabling you to achieve your ambitions in life. It's also likely that you form a fortunate marriage union.

## **Saturn is Square Neptune**

The planets Saturn and Neptune are combining in your chart suggesting that you've difficulty achieving your career ambitions. It's likely that you're a highly creative individual, but that you either lack the confidence to follow your true path, or the ability to make your dreams a reality. This doesn't necessarily mean that you aren't successful in your career, but rather that something is missing. It could be that you're dissatisfied with your career choice, because you're not following your true vocation. It's also possible that you enjoy your work, but aren't being paid well, which leads to frustration and disappointment. No matter how much other people urge you to stand up for your rights, you believe that you're not in a position to do so. The problem may be that you've difficulty stepping back and appropriately assessing all of your options. You lack the confidence to pave your own professional path, afraid to leave the security and comfort of your current job, or you're too busy chasing rainbows to manage your career. At some stage in your life you're forced to learn to believe in yourself, to find the right mix of creativity and practicality. Once you've made steps along this process you gain the confidence to continue. Like a child learning to walk for the first time, you're soon off and running.

## The Midheaven

The Midheaven is one of the important angles in a birth chart and is also known by astrologers as the MC or Medium Coeli. This angle tells us of our public life, our profession and social status. In other words how we are viewed by the public, how we want to be viewed by the public and what type of profession we are likely to choose. It's also important to note the house position of the ruling planet of your Midheaven for further information about your career as this can greatly influence the interpretation.

## The Midheaven is in Libra

With a Midheaven in the Sign of Libra and ruled by the planet Venus, you're attracted to a profession that best utilises your social or artistic skills. You're charming and diplomatic in your professional life, and these skills will be prominent in whatever career path is chosen. This could be a profession which directly utilises your talents in the areas of diplomacy, design or beauty, such as working in fashion design, interior decorating, modelling, the arts, diplomatic circles, or public relations. Alternatively you could benefit indirectly by employing these skills in a different career. This largely depends on other influences in your chart. Either way it's likely your profession reflects your need for harmony in the work environment, which is vital to you achieving your career goals. You like to create a harmonious working environment wherever you're employed, and enjoy good social relationships with your colleagues, in particular women. If your workplace lacks fellowship then you're likely to have difficulty accomplishing your tasks. Examples of famous people with the same Midheaven include American film actress Elizabeth Taylor, UK singer and actor Sir Bob Geldof, French fashion designer Coco Chanel, and American first lady Eleanor Roosevelt.

## The Moon is Conjunct The Midheaven

This is a prominent placement for the Moon indicating that you have a strong inclination to find your purpose in life and express it through your career or through parenthood. Your emotions are likely to affect your choice of career. Therefore you need to make sure that you strike out on your own journey rather than trying to please one or both of your parents. You also need to ensure that you like and respect

anyone who holds authority in your chosen profession. Otherwise you may feel uncomfortable at work. You are likely to crave recognition for your achievements. This may come in the form of praise from your colleagues or bosses, or if you receive awards in your industry. You are sensitive about your role in public, and seek a sense of security from your chosen profession. The more that you feel that you are steering your life in the right direction the more happy you are likely to be in all areas. In the same way that you feel comforted when your career is stable, you may also comfort others through your chosen profession. Perhaps you enjoy looking after your workmates, listening to their troubles and bringing them little treats, or maybe your career is in a helping profession, or the hospitality industry. Your life choices may be strongly influenced from childhood through to adulthood by your mother, or another matriach in your family.

## **CREATIVITY AND ORIGINALITY**



## **Uranus**

The planet Uranus represents originality and unconventionality. This can be both the unusual and brilliant genius or the wilful rebel without a cause. This planet tells us the areas in which we break with convention, become innovative and experiment with new and exciting ways. In some circles of astrology Uranus represents the creative genius which comes directly via our soul or higher self.

#### **Uranus is in the 8th House**

The planet Uranus is in the 8th House of your birth chart suggesting that you experience sudden gains and losses through marriage and business partnerships. You may be initially annoyed to learn of sudden losses of inheritance, or by the fact that a loved one has not bequeathed you a favourite item. However, you quickly adapt to the circumstances, recognising that they're out of your control. Life is easier once you accept that you're unlikely to benefit from legacies, unless there are other positive aspects in your chart. You're also likely to lose money through marriage and business partnerships. This could be that your spouse is poor, or that they squander money. It could also be that your business partners are unreliable or that circumstances result in a sudden change of course. If there are other favourable aspects in your chart then you could experience sudden windfalls, such as an inheritance from a virtual stranger, or a sudden influx of money from an invention or business enterprise. This placement also indicates that you're fascinated by metaphysics and the deeper side of life.

#### **Uranus is in Leo**

The planet Uranus was in the Sign of Leo from 1956 - 1962. It's important to note that Uranus spends a long time in each Sign, and therefore the interpretation applies to a generation rather than the individual. For a more individual interpretation you need to look at the house position of Uranus in your chart. Uranus in the Sign of Leo indicates that you belong to a generation which seeks freedom of individual expression. Positively this means that your generation recognises that true individual creativity is important, particularly through culture and the arts. However, negatively this can be the selfishness of a generation that is focussed on individual rights rather than communal co-operation.

## **Neptune**

Neptune is the planet of creativity and spirituality. It represents both the bliss of spiritual attainment and the heights of creativity. This isn't personal spirituality and creativity which comes at the expense of others, but gifts which can benefit humanity. This planet also represents the confusion that can accompany the road to discovering when we are being selfish, as opposed to when we are generously thinking of how our gifts can benefit others.

## **Neptune is in the 11th House**

The planet Neptune placed in the 11th House of your chart means that you're likely to be attracted to spiritual and humanitarian friends or groups. If you've positive influences in your chart then you're likely to form close unions with spiritual or artistic friends, and groups, which greatly enrich your life. You may also have an inspirational effect on your friends' lives, or act as inspirational catalyst in a group. However, if you've negative influences in your chart, then you're likely to suffer at the hands of unusual and deceitful friends and acquaintances. You may also receive bad advice from friends, which leads to loss and complications in your life. You're more likely to benefit through your friendships if you follow your intuitive, rather than a logical train of thought.

## Neptune is in Scorpio

The planet Neptune was in the Sign of Scorpio from 1955 - 1970. It's important to note that Neptune takes about 164 years to make a complete cycle, spending about thirteen years in each Sign, and therefore the interpretation applies to a generation rather than the individual. For a more individual interpretation you need to look at the house position of Neptune in your chart. Neptune in the Sign of Scorpio indicates that you belong to a generation which has the ability to passionately pursue spiritual values. You face a battle between your material desires and the desire for a spiritual way of life. You know the value of regeneration rather than stagnation, and may play a role in changing the world.

## **Neptune is Sextile Pluto**

The planets Neptune and Pluto both move slowly through the zodiac, and therefore any connection between the two planets affects birth charts for a short period of time. You were born in such a time. This combination in your chart means that you're interested in opportunities to bring about fundamental change to human values. You are aware of injustices in society and, depending on other influences in your chart, may prefer to fight against them rather than sit back and accept the ills of society. Your creative urges may be linked to politics, or expressing your political views through the arts or spiritual or charitable organisations.

## **CHALLENGES IN LIFE**



## **Pluto**

The planet Pluto challenges us to transform our lives by clearing out our old habits to make way for the new, more rewarding ways of living. The process isn't necessarily an easy one, as most of us cling tenaciously to the comfort offered by habitual patterns, and are rather scared of new paths. Pluto shows us in which areas of our lives we need to grow, and to a certain extent whether we're likely to find the process of growing painful or joyful.

#### Pluto is in the 9th House

The planet Pluto is in the 9th House of your birth chart indicating that study, religion and travel are challenging areas in your life. You probably have a powerful drive to discover higher meanings in life, but in some cases this placement of the planet Pluto can mean that you'll do all in your power to refuse to acknowledge a higher meaning. Either way it's likely that orthodox religion has played a powerful role in your life. On the one hand traditional religion may have acted as a positive avenue for your search for meaning in life, but on the other hand you may react strongly to the dogmas of more conventional religions. You've a strong need to form your own opinions based on your own experience and studies, rather than adopt another person's creed. Ironically you need to beware of becoming dogmatic in your personal philosophies. Depending on other influences in your chart it's also likely that academic study is a major challenge in your life. This could be that you intensely pursue your studies at an institute of higher learning, or it could be that you feel deeply disturbed by your lack of opportunities to pursue an academic course of study. Although you may have avoided travelling to foreign countries for part of your life, once you do travel you're likely to be changed by the experience.

#### Pluto is in Virgo

The planet Pluto was in the Sign of Virgo from 1957 - 1972. It's important to note that Pluto takes about 248 years to make a complete cycle, spending 12 - 32 years in each Sign, and therefore the interpretation applies to a generation rather than the individual. For a more individual interpretation you need to look at the house position of Pluto in your chart. Pluto in the Sign of Virgo suggests that you

belong to a generation concerned with global health and environment. Your generation possesses the ability to transform the way the world sees health. Medical research, world-wide diseases, medical discoveries, and the links between mind and body are focuses for this generation.

## **PURPOSE AND JOY**



## **The North Node**

The North Node and South Node form an axis in astrology, which is said to represent one's destiny or spiritual quest in life. This axis is also linked with our purpose. The North Node points to a key lesson in our lives. It represents new experiences towards which we must aim during this life. We have already learnt the skills of its opposite point, the South Node, in the past. Now we must grow and stretch ourselves through the North Node.

#### The North Node is in the 8th House

Your North Node is in the 8th House and your South Node is in the 2nd House of your birth chart indicating a quest to learn self-control. You need to let go of the ingrained attitudes of the past and to place emphasis on spiritual values.

## The North Node is in Leo

Your nodal axis has the North Node in Leo and the South Node in the Sign of Aquarius denoting that you're destined to develop your inner strength. You may find that you experience times of loneliness. These times are part of your lesson to forge your own creative life in order to give generously to the world.

#### The South Node is Conjunct Saturn

The combination of the South Node and Saturn is a difficult one, indicating that you face restrictions in your current life and struggle to express yourself. At times you may feel that the world is a hard place, particularly the demands of daily life. It's possible that you've inherited some emotional or physical problems from your father, or his side of the family, which restrict your ability to achieve your goals. These problems can be overcome, but it's only through hard work and shouldering your responsibilities that you're likely to achieve your purpose.

#### The Ascendant

The Ascendant, or Rising Sign as it's sometimes called, is a key to discovering our purpose. Ancient

astrologers believed that the Ascendant depicted our primary motivation as individuals. Some believed that it was one of the links to discovering what makes a person happy. When we're accomplishing our primary motivation then we're happy. The more modern Esoteric astrologers believe that this sensitive chart point reveals our soul's purpose. When we're carrying out our soul's purpose then we're joyful. They believe that acceptance of our purpose, or fate, can help us achieve success and satisfaction, and that meditation on the qualities of the Ascendant can help us focus on our life's purpose.

## The Ascendant is in Sagittarius

The Sign of Sagittarius is considered "masculine" by Ancient astrologers suggesting that you're more likely to actively seek your purpose in life, taking the initiative rather than waiting until circumstances are comfortable. Sagittarius is also a Mutable Sign denoting versatility, flexibility, adaptability, sensitivity, restlessness, indecision and anxiety.

You're open-minded, honest, idealistic, jovial, impulsive and a deep thinker. You view life as a continual adventure with many exciting lessons, experiencing good fortune on your travels. Your irrepressible enthusiasm is irresistible, and others are keen to join your adventures. You're ardent, affectionate, and kind-hearted. You need to be wary of becoming too headstrong, because your tendency to go to extremes can be exhausting both to yourself and other people. This also applies to your inclination to rush in to romantic relationships, to be extravagant and reckless. If you can restrain your impulses and harness your positive traits then you're likely to be fortunate in life and an inspiration to others.

In Esoteric astrology the Sign of Sagittarius is linked with illuminating the mind. Your purpose is connected with teaching spiritual knowledge and sharing your spiritual vision.
